RESOLUTION NO. 51

DECLARING THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, PROVINCE OF RIZAL UNDER THE STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO THE TYPHOON FLORITA AND GLENDA

WHEREAS, typhoon FLORITA AND GLENDA which occurred this month of July, 2006 caused flashfloods and damages to infrastructure at Sitio Lupang Arenda Brgy. Sta. Ana, Taytay, Rizal;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan identified different affected areas that need to be prioritized and to be undertaken by the administration, to wit;

1. Repair of San Lorenzo Pavement and Canal

2. Repair of Road leading to San Lorenzo and Lupang Arenda (West Embankment)
3. Drainage @ Lupang Arenda
4. Perimeter Fence of Taytay National High School – Main
5. Dredging of Batong Dalig Creek/Kay Tupay Creek
6. Improvement of Riprap at Batong Dalig Creek
7. Dredging of Secondary Creek, namely:
 - a. Sapang Pila Creek
 - b. Dolores Creek
 - c. Maningning Creek
 - d. Pamutas Creek
 - e. Buli Creek
 - f. S. Mateo Creek
 - g. Ilog Pugad Creek
 - h. Ilog Patoto Creek
 - i. Bangiad Creek
 - j. Sapang Libo Creek
 - k. Lagundi Creek
 - l. Sabutan Creek
8. Cleaning of drainages, particularly Rizal Avenue
9. Dredging of Taytay River

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan also adopted the Municipal Disaster Coordinating Council report concerning the affected areas and families to be prioritized;

WHEREAS, to prevent spread of diseases due to this calamities the Municipality shall adopt contingency measures concerning the health of our constituents;

WHEREAS, in order to cope with the flooding and damages brought about by said typhoon it becomes necessary that the Municipality of Taytay be declared under the STATE OF CALAMITY;

NOW THEREFORE, as it is hereby resolved, the Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay duly assembled in session hereby declares under STATE OF CALMITY brought about by Typhoon FLORITA and GLENDIA.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Local Calamity Fund shall be utilize for relief, rehabilitation, reconstruction and other works and services, to be undertaken by the administration in connection with the calamities, Such expenditures shall be governed by the guidelines and procedures prescribed under the rules and regulation implementing Republic Act. No. 8185, Amending Section 324 (d) Republic Act. 7160, together w/ the joint Memorandum Circular No. 2003-1 ,2003-2 of Department of Budget and Management & Department of Interior Local Government dated March 20,2003 and dated July 24, 2003 repectively.

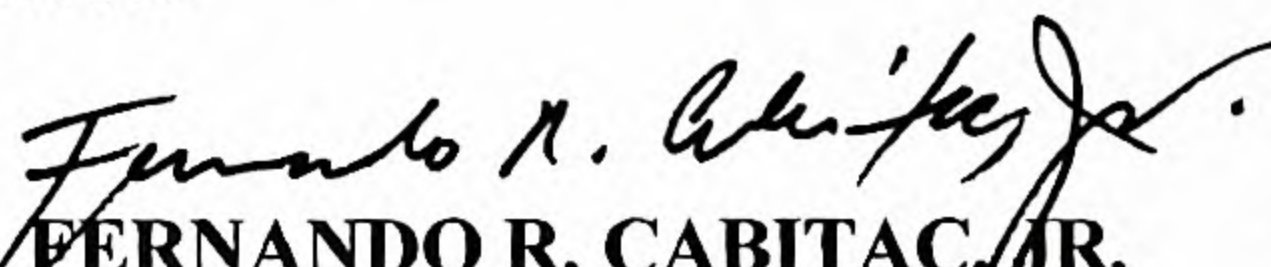
RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to all authorities concern for their information and appropriate action.
