WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates every local government unit to promote the general welfare of its constituents, including the maintenance of peace and order, health, safety, and convenience of its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section 17(b)(2)(viii) of the same Code states that infrastructure facilities such as traffic signals and road signs are among the basic services and facilities that municipalities are mandated to provide and maintain;

WHEREAS, the area surrounding the Rizal Provincial Hospital System - Taytay has been experiencing significant traffic congestion, which impedes the mobility of emergency vehicles, patients, hospital staff, and the general public;

WHEREAS, the area is surrounded by public and private facilities that also draw heavy foot traffic, such as the Minor Basilica and Parish of St. John the Baptist, San Juan Gym, and the PNP Taytay Office, and the Taytay Fire Station;

WHEREAS, it has also been observed that the high number of parked vehicles and the presence of ambulant vendors occupying road spaces and pedestrian lanes in the said area contribute significantly to the worsening of traffic flow and public safety concerns;

WHEREAS, an efficient and responsive traffic management scheme is crucial to ensure public safety, improve traffic flow, and support the proper functioning of health and emergency services in the area;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Planning and Development Office (MPDO), in coordination with the Smile Traffic Action Group, is the appropriate agency to conduct studies, formulate strategies, and implement appropriate traffic schemes in accordance with existing local and national policies;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the 13<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in session duly assembled, hereby REQUESTS THE HONORABLE MAYOR ALLAN MARTINE S. DE LEON, MPA, THROUGH THE MUNICIPAL PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE (MPDO) AND SMILE TRAFFIC ACTION GROUP (STAG) TO DEVELOP AN APPROPRIATE TRAFFIC SCHEME FOR THE AREA OF THE RIZAL PROVINCIAL HOSPITAL SYSTEM - TAYTAY.
